Chapter 1

Flow

The following standalones are available:

- *PyroNameServer* – for launching/connecting to a Pyro4[3] nameserver.
- *PyroStandalone* – for calling a Pyro4[3] remote object.
- *PythonEnvironment* – defines what executables to use, system-wide or specific ones (e.g., from a virtual environment).

The following sources are available:

- *PipExec* – executes pip.
- *PyroSource* – for generating data with a Pyro4[3] remote object.
- *PythonExec* – executes the specified Python script.
- *PythonVenvExec* – executes the specified executable from the virtual environment defined with *PythonEnvironment*.

The following transformers are available:

- *PyroTransformer* – for transforming data with a Pyro4[3] remote object.
- *PythonExpandScript* – expands variables and placeholders in a script template and saves it as a separate file.

The following sinks are available:

- *PyroSink* – for consuming data with a Pyro4[3] remote object.
